Definition

Under the direction of the Director of Technology and Systems Engineer, performs a variety of duties related to District-wide operation of computer systems; installs and maintains computer applications, and provides computer hardware support; assists as needed in daily operations of the Technology Department; and performs related work as required; keeps district staff informed and up-to-date on software and hardware changes, developments, etc.; assists the Systems Engineer in the management of information systems security; and orients users to new systems and procedures.

Examples of Duties

- 1. Provides desktop support for various computer platforms; inclusive of Microsoft Windows, Apple Mac OS, Apple IOS, and Google Chrome OS.
- 2. Configure workstations for basic network connections.
- 3. Assists and troubleshoots hardware, software, network, mobile device, audiovisual devices, and peripheral issues.
- 4. Repairs computer hardware on various systems.
- 5. Performs preventative maintenance to maintain optimal system performance.
- 6. Provides technical input to serve as a resource to administrators, teachers and staff.
- 7. Performs imaging of computer systems.
- 8. Performs basic troubleshooting of networks devices.
- 9. Maintains inventory of all computer equipment and peripherals.
- 10. Assists in basic user account management with district wide information systems
- 11. Handle general VoIP maintenance, support and configuration changes
- 12. Supports databases containing confidential information.
- 13. Collaborates with vendors for software and hardware installations, troubleshooting, and maintenance.
- 14. Maintains records in work order system.
- 15. Supports and updates District and School Site website content
- 16. Pick up and delivers equipment at District facilities.
- 17. Prepares written and oral reports as required.
- 18. Maintains knowledge of current trends in computer support.
- 19. Performs related/other duties as assigned by Director of Technology and Systems Engineer, in support of current District Technology and Future Technology that is implemented.
