### PURPOSE OF THE COMMITTEE

The Perris Elementary School District Governing Board voted August 7, 2006, to place a \$25 million bond measure on the November 7, 2006 ballot. The community approved Measure S for \$25 million with more than 55% approval of the voters in the District to finance the construction and modernization of District facilities.

On February 13, 2014 the Perris Elementary School District Governing Board voted to place a \$40 million bond measure on the June 3, 2014 special ballot. The community approved Measure C for \$40 million with more than 55% approval of the voters in the District to finance the acquisition, construction, and modernization of District facilities.

The Governing Board approved the appointment of the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) at its November 13, 2014, Board meeting.

As set forth in Prop 39, the purpose of the Measures C and S Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee is to review and report on the proper expenditure of taxpayers' money for school construction on the Measures C and S bond projects.

The Oversight Committee conducted three business meetings in Fiscal Year 2017/2018 which included the review of facilities projects and project expenditures.

The Annual Financial Statement Audit Report was provided for review at the October 18, 2018 meeting.

On behalf of the Measures C and S Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee, we are pleased to inform you that the District is in compliance with Article XIIIA, Section 1(b) (3) of the California Constitution, and the current projects are authorized under Measures C and S. All of the CBOC meeting agendas and backup information is posted on the district's website.
